### PLEASE LABEL:

- 1 Bible (NIV, ESV, KJ, NKJ, or NASB)
- 3 Spiral Notebooks / Composition Pads
- 1 12" Ruler (with english, metric, and 1/16" markings)
- 1 Protractor
- 1 Compass
- 1 Electronic Dictionary/Thesaurus (recommended)
- 1 Scientific Calculator
- 1 USB Flash Drive
- 1 Chromebook (or equivalent device) (grades 10-12 only)
- 1 Camera (300MB+) (for yearbook class when requested)
- 1 Individual Organizational System  
(3-ring binder with paper, writing utensils, and ability to easily access papers for each subject) (no smaller than 2.5")

### DO NOT LABEL:

- 2 Tissue Boxes (large)
- 2 Paper-Towels Rolls
- 1 Disinfectant Wipes Box

NOTE: These items are intended to be kept at school to help speed up participation. Some items may need to be replenished throughout the year. CCS will provide a Student Planner for each student that will require a replacement fee if lost. PE clothing shall consist of shorts that hit at or below the knee, sweat pants, athletic capris, a t-shirt/sweatshirt (no tank tops), socks, and athletic shoes (non-marking soles) with proper arch and ankle support with shoelaces tied. It is strongly suggested girls do not wear dresses on PE days.

LOCKERS: Students in secondary grades (7-12) will be assigned a locker at the beginning of the school year. Because having a locker is both a privilege and a responsibility, students are expected to adhere to the following locker regulations:

- No stickers on lockers (inside or out). Magnets and "sticky tack" are acceptable.
- Locker decor should be appropriate and free from negative slogans.
- Books need to be upright (vertical), not down flat. When they are down flat, they get caught on the inside and can tear.
- Shelves can be purchased at stores such as Office Depot, Target and Wal-Mart. Locker dimensions are 35"H x 12"W x 13"D.
- All food must be cleared out of the lockers at the end of each day.
- All lockers will be kept locked unless the assigned person is using it (no propping the doors open).
- Each student will be assigned a locker. Locker combinations are private and should not be shared with others. Any student that is caught opening or entering a locker which is not assigned to them will be disciplined.
- Students will not be allowed to switch lockers. If students are found switching lockers they will be disciplined. It is important to stay in the locker you are assigned so the office can deliver information to the proper student(s).
- Pounding on, kicking or slamming lockers is prohibited.
- Closing any locker other than your own is prohibited.
