## **Bible**

### ***Deep Roots: Bible Curriculum for Defendable Faith***

This program is an Apologetics and Worldview Bible Curriculum. It equips students with the tools and training to stand firm in the face of today's cultural challenges.

## **Reading**

### **Fluency**

***Heggerty:*** Phonemic Awareness

***UFLI Foundations:*** (University of Florida Literacy Institute)

This program introduces students to the foundational reading skills necessary for proficient reading. It follows a carefully developed scope and sequence designed to ensure that students systematically acquire each skill needed and learn to apply with automaticity and confidence.

***Lexia Core 5:*** Phonemic awareness, phonics, and fluency designed to meet each student's individual needs, while providing targeted instruction based on diagnostic data and ongoing assessment.

### **Comprehension**

***Rooted in Reading:*** Based on mentor texts: builds skills in comprehension and vocabulary, meanings and purpose of text, and comparing and contrasting literature.

### **Writing/Grammar**

***Primary Bliss:*** Students will learn how to write an opinion essay, a personal narrative, and an informational writing piece. Emphasis will be placed on sentence and paragraph structure, as well as capitalization and punctuation.

## **Math**

***ACSI Purposeful Design:*** This program gives opportunity for learning and grasping mathematical concepts in a creative format that is filtered through a Biblical worldview.

***Reflex Math:*** Equipping students with strategies for conceptualizing and building their math fluency skills.

## **Science**

***ASCI Purposeful Design:*** Students will explore God's handiwork in the world around them through hands-on learning. The emphasis is on scientific-inquiry investigations and engineering-design-process activities.
